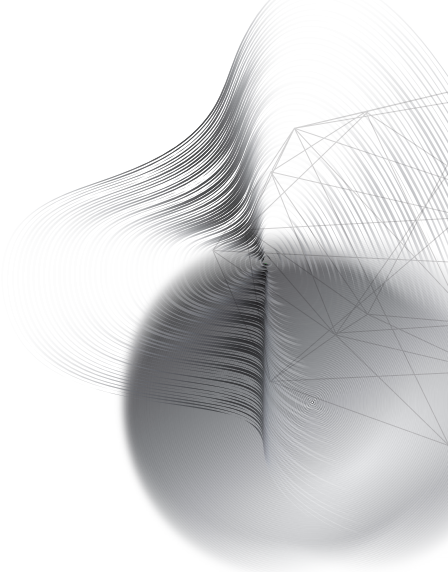

### ABOUT THE ARTISTS

Born in the southwest town of Cunnamulla, **Marlene Cummins'** traditional people are the Guguyelandji and Woppaburra. Marlene is Australia's foremost Indigenous female blues writer and performer. She refined her skills as a blues saxophonist and songwriter at the Berklee College of Music in Boston in the mid-90s. Marlene has been regular broadcaster on Koori Radio with her renowned blues show, *Marloo's Blues*. In 2014 Marlene released her first full-length album *Koori Woman Blues* to coincide with the premiere of her film *BLACK PANTHER WOMAN*.

**Wendy Ang** is a highly sought after pianist and keyboardist who has shared the stage with many great artists such as Ronan Keating, Josh Groban, David Campbell, Jessica Mauboy and Guy Sebastian. She has been involved in many productions such as *X Factor*, *Sunrise* on Channel7 and *A Night at the Rock Opera*. Wendy was the deputy keyboard player for Sydney's production of *Jersey Boys*. In 2007 Wendy toured China and Southeast Asia. She performed with Asia Beat's Lewis Pragasam in Malaysia and Indonesia at the Java Jazz Festival. Wendy completed her Bachelor of Music at the Australian Institute of Music.
